





Redetzke started racing stock cars in 1978, with stints in the Street Stocks and Hobby Stocks. In 1982 he made the jump to Late Models. He was the first WISSOTA National Champion in that division and has two WISSOTA 100 feature wins.

Redetzke retired from the sport after the 2005 season to watch his two sons, Jesse and Jake, take the wheel. In recent years, Redetzke has spent the summer weekends being a pit crew chief to both of his sons.

The many laps turned in by members of the Redetzke family of racers have not only led to victories and prestigious awards, but valuable information they have used to make the best oil pans in the busi-





From national champions to Saturday night hot-shoes, Roxbury builds winning transmissions

PRINCETON, MN - The driveline takes a tremendous amount of punishment during the course of a dirt track racing season, and one of the components that needs to stand up to that punishment is the transmission.

That's why Jim Roxbury went into the transmission building and rebuilding business more than 30 years ago.

bleed you do not have to have a clutch pedal in your car. Just shift it in gear and go. We also build Metric 200s for the Street Stock and Pure Stock racers and have in stock the Metric 200 converters for those of you who have had a problem getting them."

Roxbury's experience in racing dates back five decades and includes a variety of speed sports. He's a drag racer and has run nearly all types of drag cars, including top fuel. He also competes in open road races and Pro Rally races and has won races in Mexico, Newfoundland and the States.

Roxbury thinks of his business as a 24-hour job and is willing to help his customers any time they need him.

"At the end of the day, the shop phone rolls to the home phone, and if I'm not home it rolls to my cell phone," he said. "Sometimes you just need a question answered or a part to get to the next race. The racing season is too short to be down

waiting for an answer from someone or for a part that wasn't on the shelf.

"The racers have been good to us in helping build this business and we want to be good to them," said Roxbury.

Along with powerglides and the components for them, Roxbury Racing Transmissions also offers 9" Ford, 8" Ford and Quick Change rear ends, and rebuilds and repairs Bert, Brinn and Falcon, Three and Four speed and Metric 200 transmissions, KSE and Sweet pumps.

In 2023, Roxbury Racing also began servicing Jerico Transmissions. "We have Jerico parts on hand, or available quickly, and service them now just like all of the other popular brands," Roxbury revealed.

"We are doing much more

on 9" Ford rear ends now and have more than 150 sets of gears in stock, with more than 40 different ratios in stock. We also stock housings, axles and Fast Shaft driveshafts," Roxbury noted.

Roxbury also offers a rear end gear and transmission rental program for those racers in need.

"If you're not sure what gear ratio you need, you can rent one and try it before you buy it," said Roxbury.

Roxbury has transmissions and rear ends in race cars nationwide, plus in Canada and Mexico - but does the vast majority of its business within a five state area around its westcentral Minnesota location.

"We also sell and repair Mod Four FOG transmissions and 8" Ford rear ends and gear sets," added Roxbury. "Finding parts for the FOG transmission is a challenge, as Ford stopped production on most parts in 1981. We have built up a good inventory of parts and are adding to that any time we find more."

Customers are welcome to stop by any time to talk and see what's new in transmission and rear end technology as well as check out the expanded inventory of day-to-day race parts.

"We're not a speed shop, but we try to have the parts that you may need to get through the weekend when other shops aren't open," Roxbury added.

Roxbury and his employees are also available trackside during the summer at many area ovals and offer on-site assistance to all of their customers. Even if you are not yet a customer at Roxbury, they are willing to try to help.

"We try to have someone at many of the tracks we normally have customers running at,' Roxbury said. "We carry spare transmissions with us and carry parts that may be needed. If one of our customers has a problem of any kind, our spare is their spare, and they can run it until their own transmission is fixed."

For those outside the area. Roxbury can ship transmissions and parts to your location via Speedee, UPS, FedEx, U.S. mail or by truck.

"For our Canadian customers we have drop locations that we can have drop shipped to the border and all you have to do is cross and pick up," Roxbury explained. Roxbury also accepts payment by Visa, Mastercard and PavPal.




Koehler and Simpson may be the highest profile winners with the brand in 2025, but they weren't the only drivers to win with Cyclone this season.

T&D Machine Products: 50 years of rocker arm reliability that's second to none


